

CommUNITY Barnet 40th Anniversary Photo Competition Terms & Conditions

Who can enter

- The competition is open to residents and people working, volunteering and studying in the London Borough of Barnet.
- The photograph you choose to enter must be your own work, we will only accept one entry per person in each category and the photograph must have been taken in the London Borough of Barnet.

Categories of the competition

- The categories for the competition are:
 - (i) Culture & Communities in Barnet This can include photographs of individuals or groups of people in the community.
 - (ii) Buildings & Environment in Barnet This can include photographs of historical areas, nature areas and more.

Prizes

There will be prizes in both categories and are as follows:
 1st prize - £150 cash, 2nd prize - £50 cash and 3rd prize - £25 cash

The criteria for judging

- Entries will be judged upon their merit as the most interesting, creative and engaging images of each category
- We may disregard any entry that does not comply with competition rules.

How to enter

- Send one digital image, to a maximum of one image in each category, with a maximum file size
 of 10MB to 40@communitybarnet.org.uk
- Images must be sent to us in JPEG format, but can be taken in any format you choose
- You must include your first name and telephone number as the title of the image i.e
 Peter02083492222
- The subject of the email should be 40 Photo Competition
- In the main part of the email please include your full name, address and contact details (these will not be displayed publicly) and a brief description of the photo.

Rules and Guidelines

- By entering this competition, you agree to abide by the rules of the competition.
- Entries will open from Monday 3rd June 2019 and will close on Monday 30th September 2019.
- Basic editing, including colour enhancement, the use of filters, and cropping of the photograph is
 acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity and/or genuineness of the
 photograph.
- Advanced editing used to create illusions, deceptions and/or manipulations, and the adding and removing of significant elements within the frame is prohibited.



- Any photographs submitted to this competition will be the intellectual property of CommUNITY Barnet, which we may display digitally or physically, or reproduce for non-commercial purposes at any time.
- Photographs cannot contain sexually explicit, nude, obscene, violent or other objectionable or inappropriate content.
- Photographs cannot involve the wilful harassment of wildlife, or damage to the environment by the photographer.
- Photographs cannot involve putting any individual or animal in danger.
- Entrants who take photographs of individuals must obtain the individual's permission to have their photograph taken before submitting the image to CommUNITY Barnet.
- CommUNITY Barnet shall determine entry eligibility at its own discretion.
- By entering, you agree to be bound by these rules in relation to the prize competition. No other cash alternative will be offered.
- The winners will be selected by a panel of judges. Their decision is final on all matters and no further correspondence will be entered.
- No employees of CommUNITY Barnet can enter the competition.
- By entering this competition, you agree to have read the terms and conditions and be bound by them.

How and when will be winners be notified, and when they will receive their prizes

- Judging will take place from Monday 30th September 2019.
- Winners will be announced at the Community Barnet AGM in November 2019 and will be
 notified privately 2 weeks prior to the AGM. Prizes will be presented at the AGM and winners
 will be invited to attend. If winners are unable to attend they can claim their prize up to 2 weeks
 after the AGM. If a winner is unable to claim their prize within this time their prize will be
 forfeited.
- Winners will also be announced on our website.
- We may publish the names of winners in our publications, local newspapers and online and may also use any of the entries in our publications, online, in local newspapers and at public events.
