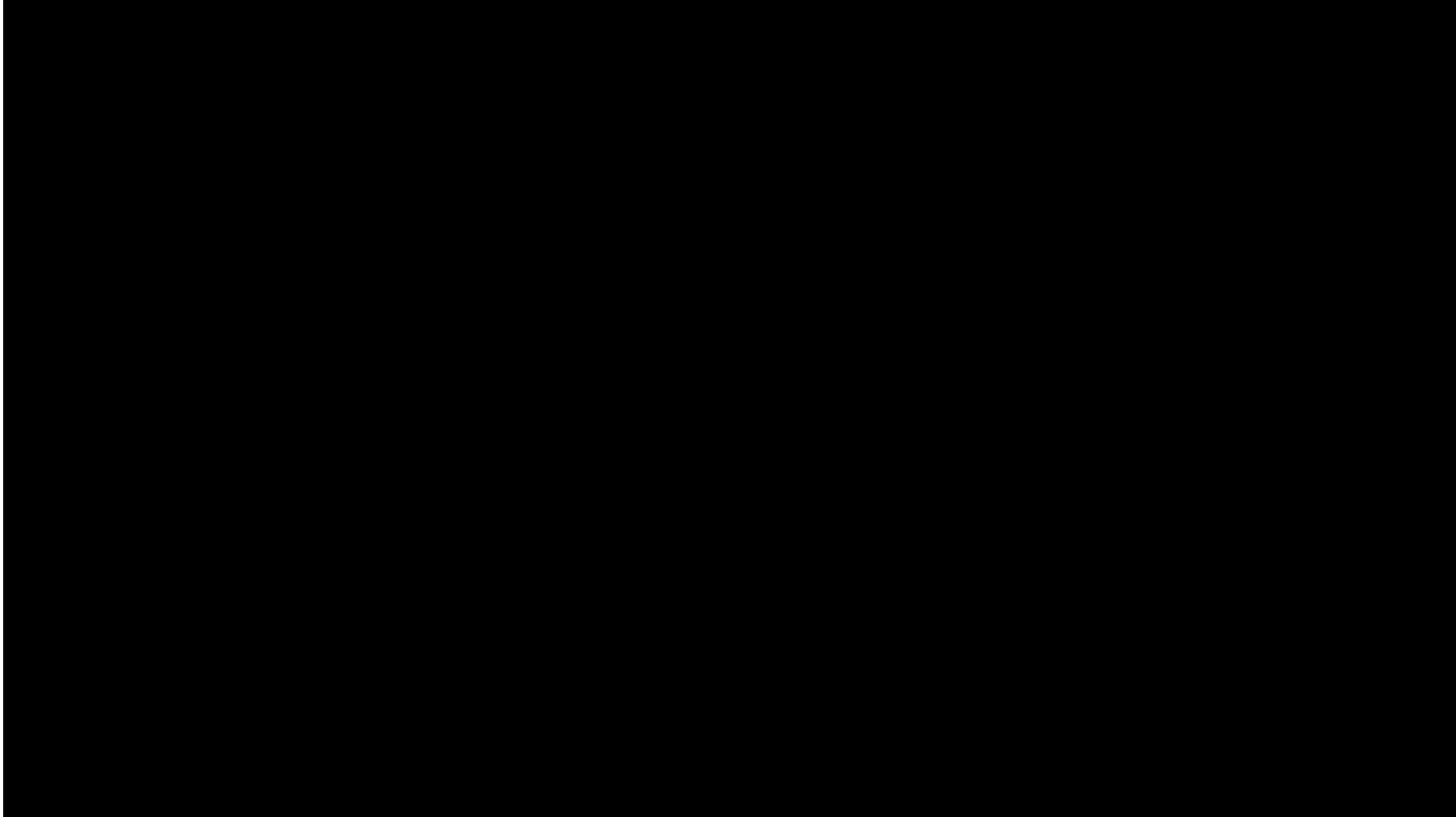

Who are we

- ▣ Established in 1999 by self made millionaire Sir Jack Petchey
- ▣ We are a youth charity, dedicated to enabling 11-25 year olds to succeed, and play a full part in society.
- ▣ We have given over £100 million in grants since 1999, with over £1 million going to schools and youth groups in Barnet.

Achievement Awards Scheme

How does it work?

- ▣ Our flagship programme, operates in nearly 2000 schools across London and Essex.
- ▣ It is a peer recognition scheme, young people nominate each other for achievements.
- ▣ Awards are not about being the best, but **doing your best**.

- Winners receive a framed certificate, badge, and letter from Sir Jack, which should be presented in front of their peers.



And

- ▣ £250 to spend on items/ trips that will benefit the young people and organisation.
- ▣ Funds have been used for trips to theme parks, costumes for a play, and the most popular..... Nandos

How Many Winners?



Bronze Scheme – Entitles you to 3
award winners a year
£750 provided per year.



Silver Scheme – Entitles you to 6
award winners a year
£1500 provided per year.



Gold Scheme – Entitles you to 9
award winners a year
£2250 provided per year..

Celebrate

- ❑ The Foundation organises annual Celebration events for schools in each borough, and regional events for clubs.
- ❑ Award winners are presented with their medallions and celebrated in front of family and friends.
- ❑ A night of great entertainment, special guests, and inspirational young people.



Grant reports

- ▣ We appreciate that you have very busy schedules, so try and make the scheme as admin friendly as possible.
- ▣ We simply ask that you report back to us in November and June, detailing who the winners are and how their funds have been spent.

Leaders Award

- ▣ A way to recognise adult leaders who go that extra mile
- ▣ Young people nominate an adult (21+) who volunteers or works within the organisation.



- ❑ Leader Award winners receive a certificate and medallion.
- ❑ AND..... With this award, you can apply for a small grant of up to £750 to use for projects/ trips and equipment.

- ❑ Funded Christmas and summer events.
- ❑ Trips in the UK and beyond
- ❑ Equipment



Educational Visits

- ▣ This is a grant of up to £300 for trips of an educational nature, participating groups can apply for twice a year.
- ▣ We have funded trips to the Globe Theatre, and careers workshops.

- ▣ Registered charity
- ▣ State Secondary school
- ▣ Local authority youth club
- ▣ Not for profit organisation
- ▣ Based in London/Essex
- ▣ Regularly work with 12 or more, 11–25 year olds
- ▣ Actively promoting the growth and development of young people.
- ▣ Committed to participation of young people in decision making.
- ▣ Committed to diversity and inclusion.
- ▣ Financially sustainable.
