Telephone Befriender Licensed Trade Charity [BNT 1292] The Licensed Trade Charity need volunteer Telephone Befrienders to make friendship calls to those who are at risk of social isolation. Our team of volunteer Telephone Befrienders make regular friendship calls to an agreed number of telephone friends who are at risk of social isolation. These calls provide someone with a listening ear and helps people to rebuild their confidence and reintegrate themselves back into the community.

Ward Visitor for Hospital Radio Hospital Radio Barnet [BNT 1318] Are you chatty and have some spare time? Then could you help as a Local Volunteer Ward Visitor for Hospital Radio within Barnet Hospital? This is an opportunity for those who like to bring cheer to others! The volunteer role would be to tour the wards and chat with the patients and collect music requests. This is already done in the afternoon and evenings, but we are keen to expand this activity to cover more hours, if we can find people with a spare hour or two to help do that.
